2023 Annual Ministry Report

Dear Friends,

As every year passes, we thank the Lord for allowing us to join Him in the greatest assignment the world has ever known: reaching the nations where Jesus is unknown! Now is the time for the Body of Christ to prioritize these regions of the world and make His name known among them. None of us can do it alone, which is why we must all do it together! We are so grateful to see you enthusiastically expressing yourself in this agenda. As we celebrate what God has done through our partnership together in this annual report, we also fix our eyes on the opportunities that are ahead.

According to the Joshua Project, there are 44 countries that are less than 5% Christian. None of them are in North or South America or even Sub-Sahara Africa. All of them rest in the Eastern Hemisphere in the area known as the 10/40 Window. If we are going to complete the assignment of reaching these people, and others like them, it must become a burning passion within the hearts of those who follow Christ. For World Mission, now Unknown Nations, that is our sole focus!

This past year we sent 85,000 audio Bibles to these regions, which allowed the primarily spoken-word dependent communities to absorb the Word of God. Power was released as the Bible promises in Isaiah 55:11. That is because all of the weapons God gives us in Ephesians 6 are defensive...except one! This one will produce fruit and accomplish what God intended, which is to take ground.

It is the same with my word.

I send it out, and it always produces fruit.

It will accomplish all I want it to
and it will prosper everywhere I send it.

Isaiah 55:11

Earlier this year, we heard of people in Myanmar who were bound by witchcraft. Our team gave them an audio Bible and they listened to the Word of God and heard about Jesus for the first time. The Sword of the Spirit pierced the lies that bound these precious people who practiced sorcery and their traditional Buddhist worldview. They continued devouring the scriptures every night for a month. It touched their hearts and set them free!

Recently, they shared that they had finished their first six months of listening without missing a single day. The Word has taken ground by releasing the captives. Now they have been baptized and are in our leadership training sessions so that they can be equipped by Burmese speaking leaders to share the gospel. More ground will be taken as they each will establish dozens of new listening groups. Their testimony is already impacting people who have never heard of Jesus. Can you imagine the scene? Over and over again the Word of God sets prisoners free, those who were chained by the grip of Islam, Hinduism and Buddhism. Truth prevailed and ground was taken this past year. This report testifies to the power of God's Word and we celebrate with those who partnered with us in sharing the gospel!

That is what we will be doing over and over again in this coming year as 100,000 audio Bibles are sent to places where Jesus is unknown. Thank you for joining us in this amazing assignment. Together we will impact these areas of the world for the first time in history. Not in our own strength, but by using the precious Word of God, which is the only force on heaven or Earth that has the power to reclaim this ground for which Jesus gave His life.

CELEBRATING THE SEASONS

As a new season approaches, Dan Hibma, one of the founding members of World Mission, sat down with our CEO, Greg Kelley, to look back at pivotal moments in the ministry's history.

In 1994, Paul Land, a successful West Michigan businessman was looking for an opportunity to make a bigger impact. He'd been actively involved on a local board and his term was coming to an end.

Dan - Paul's term was up, and he just couldn't imagine only doing one thing. He was already working independently with orphanages and some other projects. Paul Land and Roger Zylstra really were the nucleus that started World Mission, along with Roger Lucas and me.

In December of 1994, World Mission was founded. The very next year, they planned to host their first golf event to raise money for an orphanage in Sarajevo. In need of help, they reached out to a young

business professional, named Greg Kelley, and asked if he would volunteer to plan the event.

At the time, Greg said he was too busy and threw the information in the trash. However, he felt like God told him to pull it back out and get involved. He started as the first volunteer.

In the early days, World Mission had their hands in a lot of projects.

Dan - They wanted to do orphanages, build wheelchair ramps, work with Christian schools and hospitals, Youth for Christ, and food wagons. I think everybody just wanted to do some good things.

Three years after the first golf outing, World Mission needed an Executive

Director and Paul Land gave Greg a call.

Greg - So I'm sitting in my insurance office, and Paul's calling. He asked me, "Hey, what are you doing?" I didn't know he meant, what are you doing for the rest of your life. He just said, "Well, when can you start?"

Shortly after that phone call, Greg started as the new Executive Director at World Mission. He quickly dove into all of the work that was being done.

In 2001, a pivotal moment took place when Dan was introduced to the Talking Bible, an audio device that played the Bible. He sat down and met with Dr. Harvey Hoekstra, the creative mind behind the project and pioneer in reaching spoken-word reliant people groups with the Gospel.

Dan - Harvey had this idea. He had a unit they called the Talking Bible and they wanted someone to manufacture and distribute it. I thought it was a pretty cool project and liked the fact there wasn't a preacher on it. It was just the Bible. And we know the Word will not return void. When they left, I immediately walked over and gave it to you (Greg) and said, 'Hey, here's a project.'

Greg - I look at the day you walked into my office as a defining moment. But then shortly after we were asking ourselves, where are these going to go? We started doing QVC [to sell units]. Then I read the book "Unveiled at Last", which talked about all of these unreached people groups. It felt like this was the direction. It became a target.

This concept was seeded in Greg's heart and he began to encourage the board to focus on primarily reaching the unreached.

At that time, Dan, Greg and one other friend began a weekly prayer meeting to ask God to guide and direct them in their ministry efforts. They had a whiteboard and would pray and write down goals as they felt led. This was instrumental in the path forward.

Dan - There was probably less of a calling at the start. And then it became an opportunity to fulfill a calling. Then with the Treasure, even more.

Greg - It's interesting, because when you think about it like that, we've had this growth that's happened with the ministry. Yet as the growth has happened, the focus has become narrower. The narrower focus has really helped us grow.

Dan - Yeah, I think that's a good perspective. The more focused you've become, the greater the impact.

A new pivotal moment is on the horizon. The name World Mission, is officially changing to Unknown Nations, leaning more into the laserfocused calling of the ministry.


Greg - From the beginning I said to Dan, we're thinking about a name change. I wanted to make sure I had your blessing.

Dan - Yes, you've got my blessing. And you know, each change has expanded the ministry more. Changing the name is pivotal. Changing the name from Talking Bible to the Treasure was pivotal. Deciding to do the Treasure was a pivotal moment. And then starting the ministry was pivotal.


Looking back on almost 30 years of ministry, it's powerful to see God's hand at work to reach the ends of the Earth and also how He's impacted the individuals involved in the ministry.

Dan - I went a couple times to Africa, and you can see the impact there. But I think it also makes an impact here ... It's an unquenchable task. An unquenchable thirst for the task. Every tribe, every tongue, every nation.

World Mission's path has been defined by pivotal moments, each sharpening our focus and magnifying our impact as a ministry. Now, as we embark on this new chapter as Unknown Nations, we remain inspired by the unquenchable desire to reach every nation. This is a tribute to nearly three decades of dedication as a ministry.



A FRUITFUL YEAR!

In the spiritually dark, hostile, barrier ridden places where we work, there is no such thing as a lukewarm Christian. Following Jesus means making a life or death decision for many new believers. They choose Jesus knowing they may pay with their life because of the great persecution in places like Pakistan, Afghanistan, Iran and northern Nigeria.

Yet in those spiritually dark and destitute places, we have had the privilege of watching God move in extraordinary ways including physical healings, angelic encounters, and the changing of hearts like Saul to Paul. The Lord is the Lord of the harvest. He brings change. He brings the fruit. We give glory and thanks for all He has done this past year. And He has done so much!

We are also grateful for you, our partners and friends who answered His call to bring more people to Jesus. This past fiscal year (ending June 30, 2023), our contributions totaled \$4,403,772, almost a 10% increase over the previous year. Our partnerships are also growing, as new people, churches, and businesses are eagerly wanting to participate in Jesus'last words.

Because of you, 85,000 Treasures were distributed. Because of you, more than 6,000 churches and listening groups were planted. Because of you, more than 8 million people heard the gospel for the first time. Thank you for answering God's call!

We are also good stewards of the funds that have been entrusted to us. Of your donated dollars, 82% went towards ministry expenses, 9% towards administrative expenses and 9% towards fundraising.

Friends, we are making progress but the need is still great. The number of people without access to the gospel is growing every day. There are 3 billion people in the world who have never had an opportunity to know Jesus. Can you imagine going through your whole life and never knowing a relationship with Jesus was possible? I can't. Not on our watch!

As a ministry, our ultimate goal is to fuel an indigenous church planting movement within each nation where we work. In 2024, we are increasing those efforts. We plan to distribute more than 100,000 Treasures on the field coupled with significant discipleship and training opportunities for our indigenous leaders and network.

We believe the Lord will bless these efforts and ask that you continue to walk alongside us and encourage others to join! Would you prayerfully consider increasing your support beyond what you are giving now and encourage a friend or family member to get involved? We commit to ongoing feedback, testimonies and stories showing ministry impact as we work together to reach the ends of the Earth.

This year was our most fruitful year yet, and we're believing for exponential growth in the coming year!





HEALING IN JESUS' NAME

A young family in Afghanistan met tragedy after the Taliban took control. The mother was running a tailoring business in their small village and her husband was working in the military. As the Taliban rose in power they started hunting for him.

They placed a bomb under his car when he was dropping off his two children at school. The blast took his life and damaged both kids' ears causing them to lose their ability to hear. The loss this young family faced was devastating.

The mother was at the lowest point of her life after losing her husband and seeing her children suffer. She continued her tailoring work to support her family, and shortly after met a new client who wanted her to stitch a skirt.

The client had an audio Bible that she was listening to at the time. The young mother asked, "Is that a mobile?" But this new friend told her it was an audio Bible and they began talking. After hearing this young mother's story and her struggles, the friend prayed with her and let her borrow the audio Bible, but just for a week.

The more she listened to the audio Bible, the more this mother was filled with peace, strength, joy and hope. But she grieved over her sons because they couldn't hear this Word of God. As soon as she was having this thought, she heard John 14:14 on the player. It said, "If you ask anything in my name, I will do it."

Right away, she laid her hands on her children and commanded their ears to be normal again in Jesus' name. **After this simple request in faith, her children's hearing was restored!** They received new ears from their loving heavenly Father!

This family received Christ and they are now sharing this testimony with others as well.

influence to embracing one thing. We became laserfocused on Jesus' last four words, His last expressed heart's desire: relationship with people at the ends of the Earth (Acts 1:8).

At that moment, our vision changed. Our organization's identity shifted.

In the Bible when God changed a person's name it was usually connected with Him establishing a new

identity. Abraham, Sarah and Israel are all new names that God gave as He changed the identity of Abram, Sarai and Jacob. In the New Testament when Jesus called Simon, which means "God has heard", He gave him the name Peter to match His new assignment. As the leader of the apostles, he required a new name that meant "rock."

God has given World Mission a new identity that we have fully embraced. We take the gospel to the nations that do

not know about the love of God and we mobilize the Body of Christ that is unaware of the nations lacking a gospel witness. Our new name, Unknown Nations, will allow us to have more fluid conversations about this new identity.

Now, we are able to re-brand and establish our vision in a more clear and meaningful way. We are resetting the definitional standards that have relegated the word unreached to mean any mission field despite the spiritual condition. There will be no more confusion between us and other organizations that may have World or Mission in

Most importantly, the name Unknown Nations is very relevant in identifying our vision. It directly connects into the mission statement of the Apostle Paul which is found in Romans 15:20, "It has always been my ambition to preach the gospel where Christ was not known." These are the words that reveal how the greatest missionary in history stewarded the Great Commission.

So, welcome to a new chapter in our laser-focused efforts to make Jesus known to the nations that have never heard His name! None of us can finish this task alone. It must become our passion and priority.

Join us at Unknown Nations in taking the gospel to the hardest and most spiritually antagonistic places on earth. No one has built a foundation there. No one knows Jesus there. Now is our time to fulfill His final words, even unto the ends of the Earth!

REACHING THE NATIONS

In a spirit filled meeting, our Indigenous Leader and his team sat down with three individuals who were united by a singular goal – distributing the Treasure. As the team got to know these individuals, they made a bold request for 1,000 Treasures. This came as a shock to the team as they had never entrusted anyone with more than 100 Treasures. After careful consideration, they put together specific expectations and allocated them 43 units.

This was just the beginning of a miraculous success story among the Hausa people in Nigeria.

These three individuals rallied four communities and generously gifted Treasures to the people. No instructions, no formal training—just a simple request for feedback. Following this encounter was nothing short of revival that swept through these regions.

Sharing Treasures with the older generation opened the door for the Chief and all of the elders in these four areas to give their lives to Christ. They reached out to our leader, requesting a teacher who could help explain the scriptures to them.

These communities, having only listened to the Treasures, were hungry for answers to their questions.

Many were deeply moved by the story of Judas betraying Jesus, struggling to comprehend the depths of such betrayal. To help them understand, the team drew a powerful parallel – we too have betrayed God by rejecting His offer of salvation. **This revelation was a turning point, leading to 49 people being baptized.**

Today, more than 129 Treasures have been distributed in these areas and many are learning about Jesus for the first time. **Two churches have been planted and the team is actively training pastors to serve in these communities.** They carefully selected four dedicated believers to attend

They carefully selected four dedicated believers to attend our leader's mission school. Following discipleship training, they will return to minister among their own people.

An entire community of non-believers planted churches themselves, drawn to God's Word by listening to the Treasure. Now, evangelists from these areas are sharing the Good News in other regions, sharing the transformative message of the gospel.



INTRODUCING THE HAUSA

The Hausa people live across 16 African countries, primarily in Central and Western Africa. The majority live in Nigeria (38 million) and Niger (13 million). Life for the Hausa remains very difficult. Poverty results in poor nutrition, illness, inadequate health care, and lack of educational opportunities. Most of the regions where the Hausa live are prone to drought. All the people share similar beliefs and customs. For these reasons, it is very difficult for Hausa to receive the gospel, as it leads to family persecution and rejection.

Coordinated Efforts: Proper training equips leaders to work together efficiently, providing direction and support for their missions, promoting unity and shared purpose.


